

TAKE ONE PICTURE is The National Gallery's programme for primary schools across the UK. Children and teachers are invited to put one painting at the heart of their learning, unleash their creativity and celebrate the potential of art across the whole curriculum.



In 2019 and in 2021, children in year 4 across the Trust investigated two paintings to help develop their art skills but also their writing and vocabulary.

Research conducted by University Of Northampton with Trust teachers and children revealed improved outcomes by the end of the programme in learning and the teaching of art, writing and C21st skills including children's self-belief, motivation, empathy and critical thinking.
