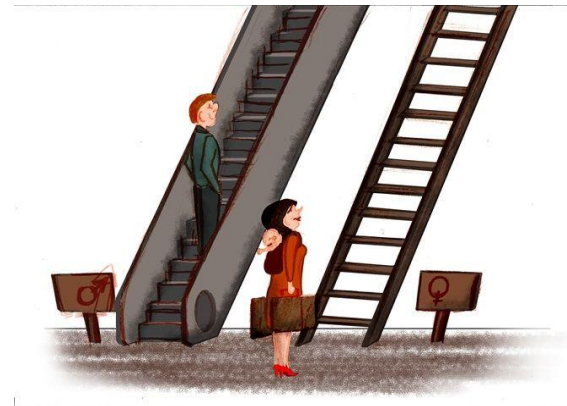
Reality & Inequality

(Oxford English Dictionary)

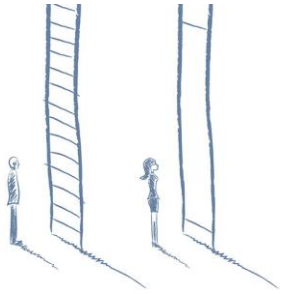
Inequality - *the phenomenon of unequal and/or unjust distribution of resources and opportunities among members of a given society.*

(International Encyclopedia of Human Geography (Second Edition), 2020)



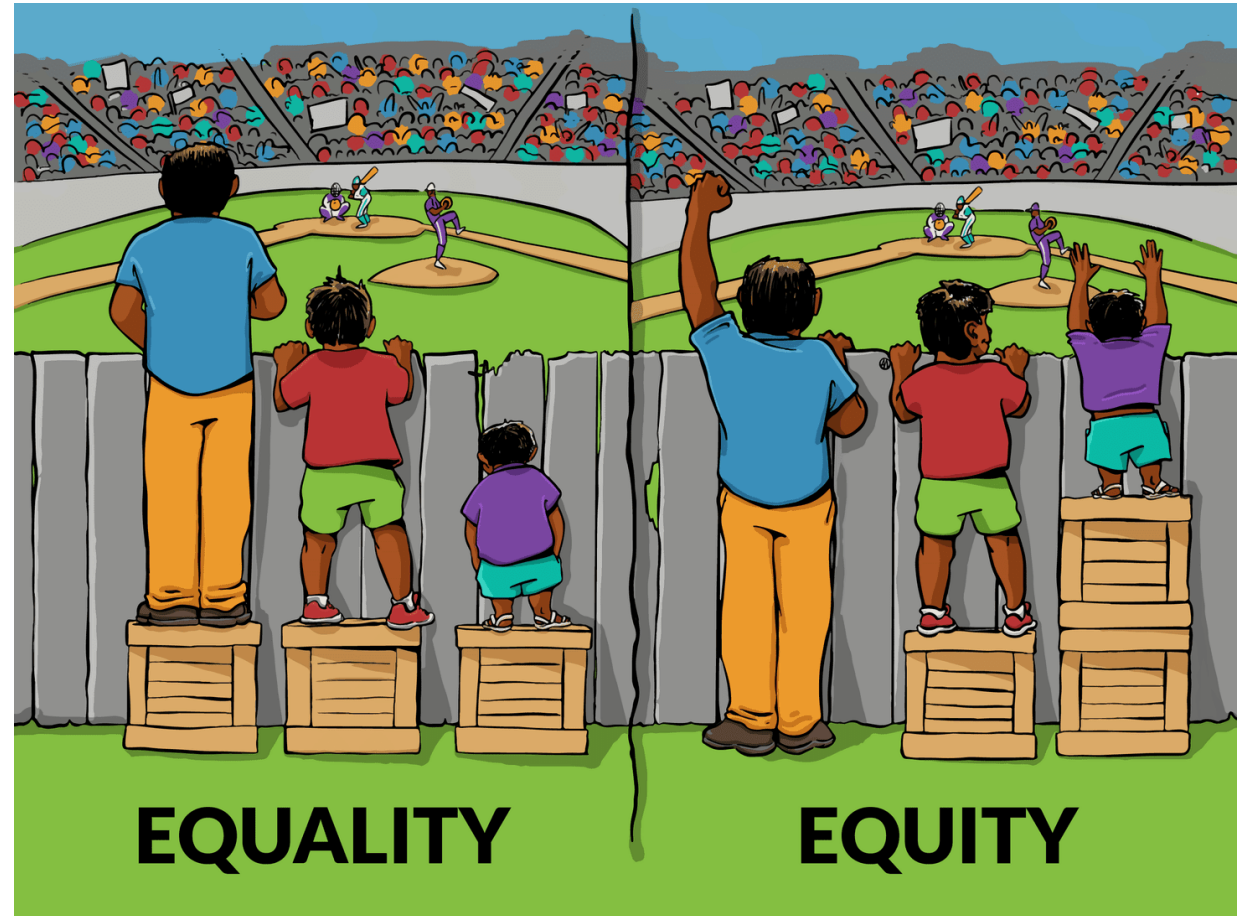

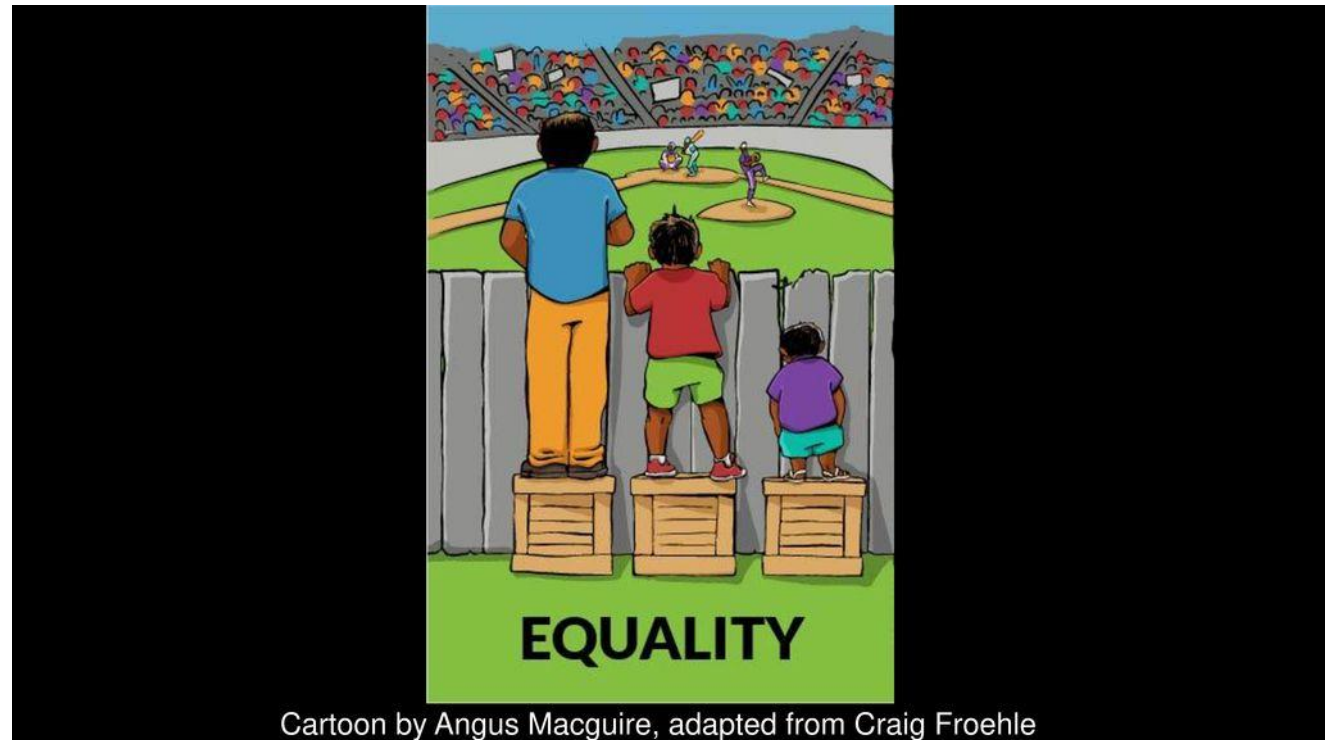
Equality vs equity

Define Equality

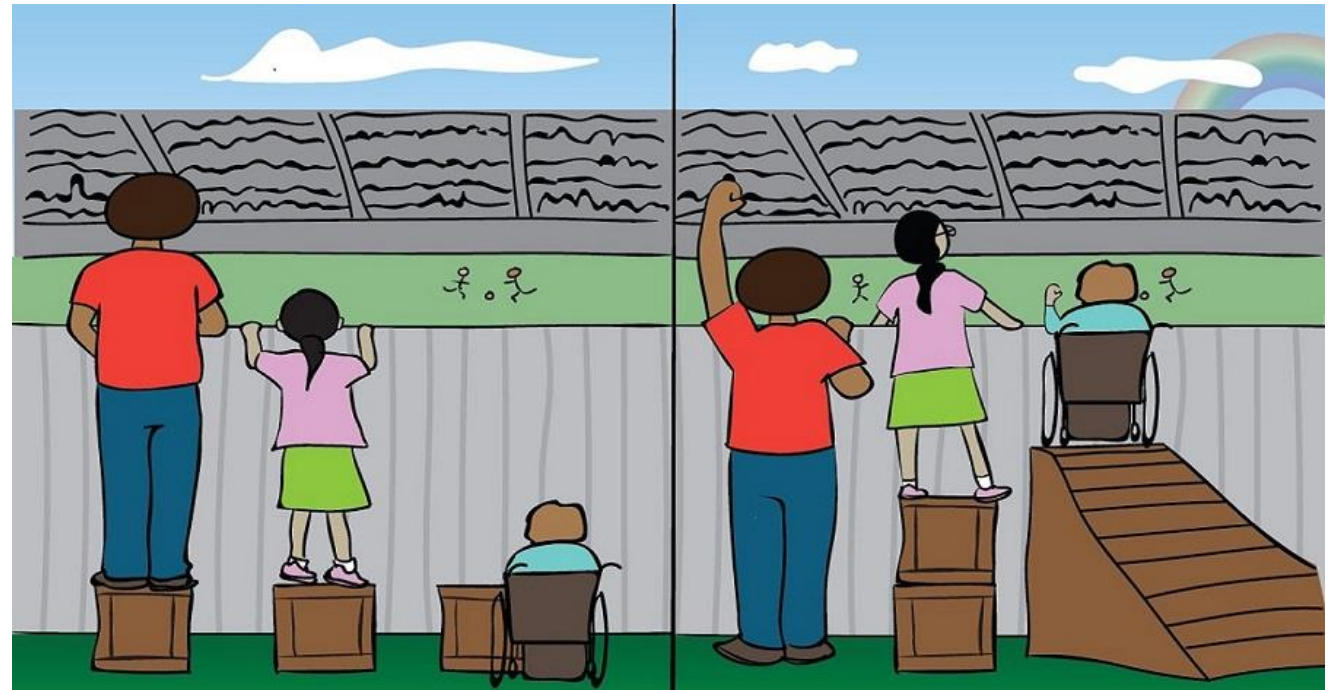
Everyone is treated exactly the same regardless of circumstance and/or need.

Realisation that everyone's circumstances are not the same, in turn are provided with what they need to succeed.

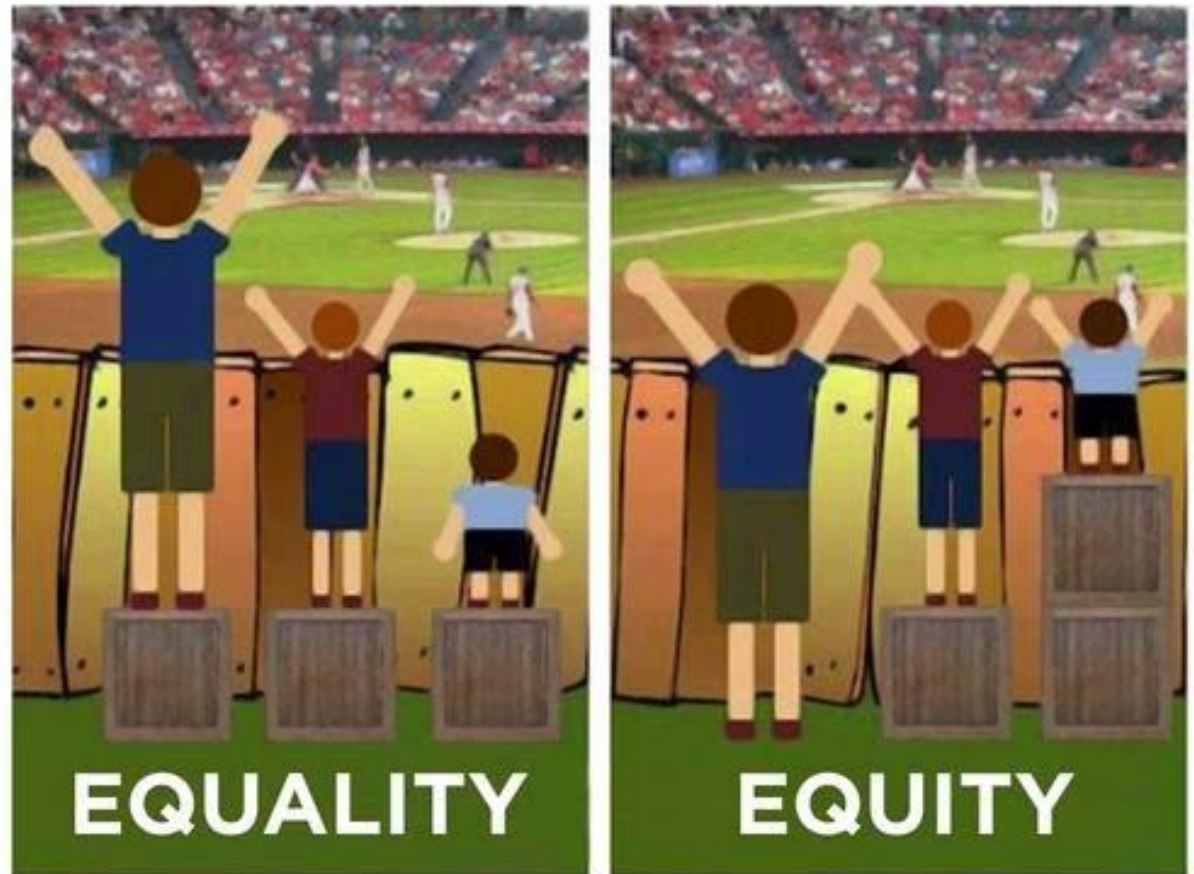

Equality



The assumption is that **everyone benefits from the same supports**. This is equal treatment.

Equity



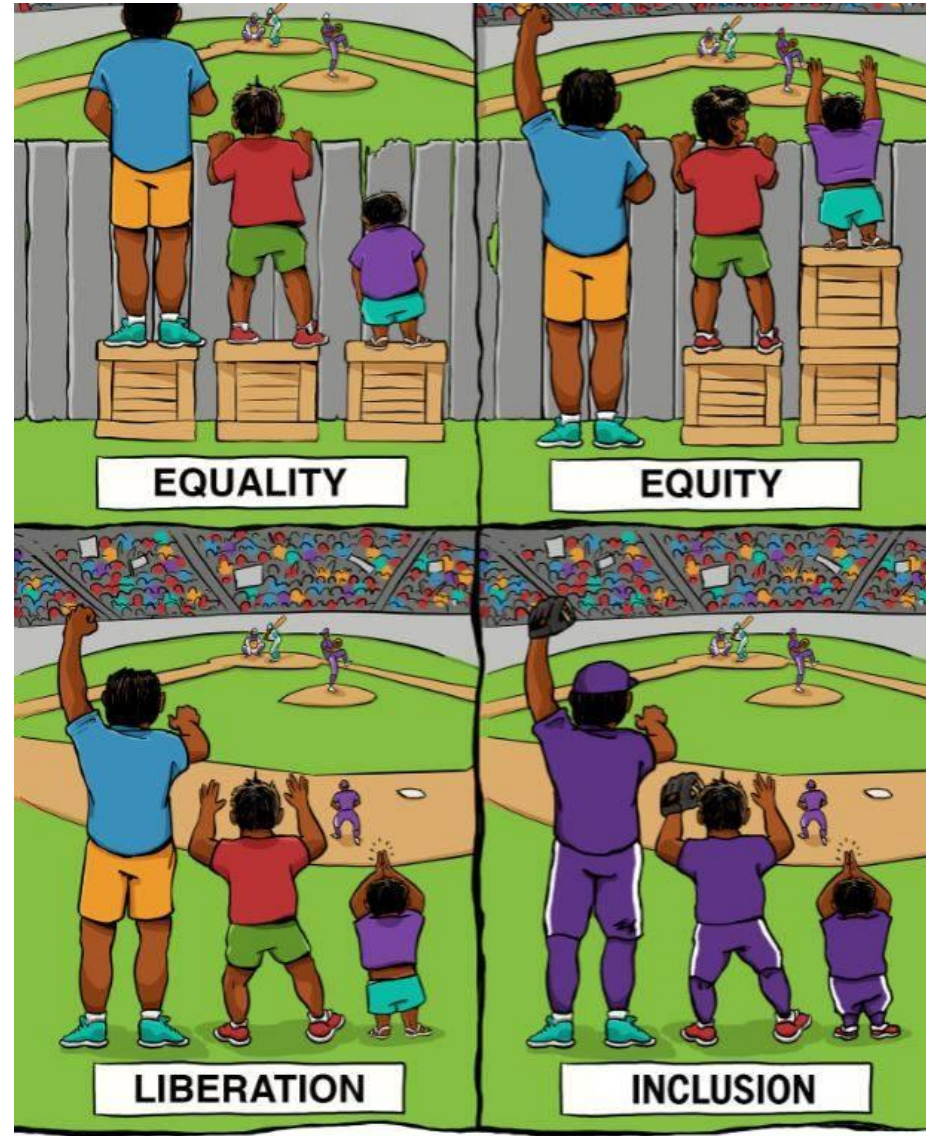
Everyone gets the supports they need (this is the concept of "affirmative action"), thus producing equity.

Justice



All 3 can see the game without supports or accommodations because **the cause(s) of the inequity was addressed**. The systemic barrier has been removed.
