

Teaching with Tablets

Free online course starting February 2016,
delivered by the School of Education

Teaching with Tablets is a new, completely free, interactive and participatory online course revolutionising how teachers can make the best use of iPads and other tablets in teaching and learning.

Each week the course will suggest innovative activities and ideas to put into practice within the teaching environment, including:

- digital storytelling
- the best apps and techniques for manipulating media
- recording learning within the classroom
- plus many more.

The course opens in February 2016 and lasts for 5 weeks. It is completely self-paced, and fits entirely around your schedule.

It is recommended to allow approximately 3 hours per week, however it is up to you how much you join in.

Throughout the course, you will have the opportunity to create and share resources with an online community that you will retain access to, even after the course finishes.
