

## What challenges did you face?

Having the confidence to contribute as 'only' an ECR

Working with people in different disciplines (quant/qual)

• Dealing with sector hopes/expectations!

• 'Impact' **not just individual** or about *me* and *my* research

Be more confident in your experience and knowledge and what you can contribute.

 Understanding the different contexts that people work in and the realities of their work
