



What is race?

The term race is **problematic on conceptual grounds** and therefore difficult to define.

According to Gillborn (2008, p.3) "Far from being a fixed and natural system of genetic difference, 'race' is a system of socially constructed and enforced categories that are constantly recreated and modified through human interaction".

What is racism?

In the UK, race has tended to be a term used to politicise racism and to address racial and/or social exclusions.

Racial discrimination; prejudice and discrimination; beliefs – inferior v superior.





