1. Personal Learning	Note taking/ management
	Resource collation/ management
2. Presentation delivery	Traditional delivery
	Student-paced, student device delivery
3. Tutor Questioning	Simple objective testing e.g. MCQs/Quizzes
	Complex objective testing
	Gamified objective testing
	Free text response questions
	Surveying/opinion seeking questions
4. Collaborative Tasks	Creation, Ideas generation, brainstorming, collation
	Planning
	Working on shared documents
	Peer Review/assessment
5. Student Questioning	Students posing questions to tutors
