### **About the competition:**

**The poster winner will receive £30 in amazon vouchers, with second place receiving £20 in amazon vouchers and third place receiving £10 in amazon vouchers.**

### **Competition guidelines**

- **Each entrant should complete an original piece of work.**
- **Only one poster allowed per entrant.**
- **Posters must relate to an aspect of consent.**
- **We recommend that all posters are A1 in size.**
- **Posters can be landscape or portrait orientation.**
- **Printed posters do not have to be laminated.**
- **It is the responsibility of entrants to arrange for the printing of their poster.**
- **Posters must be printed and displayed on the designated poster board on the morning of 8 December 2017 in Cottesbrooke Hub.**

### **Judging criteria:**

**Posters will be assessed according to two criteria:**

- **Poster design – presentation and visual communication**
- **Content – how easily this can be understood**
